Ashley Action!

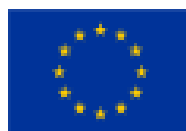
We are proud to announce our nomination as finalists at The Autism Professionals Awards 2018 and we are shortlisted in the 'Inspirational Education Provision' team award!
